Luminous Design Studios was launched in May, 2010 to provide a new umbrella for Eric's design projects in the Television and Themed Entertainment segments of the lighting design business. Recent projects include:

- *ABC 2014 Winter Olympic Coverage* – Sochi, Russia  
Broadcasting from a booth built atop the Russian Seasons hotel, overlooking the Coastal Olympic cluster, Eric lit the broadcast booth used by ABC's Good Morning America and World News Tonight.
- *China Central Television New Studios* – Beijing, China  
Subcontracted to The Lighting Design Group, Eric was one of 3 lighting designers working for 2 months in the new CCTV tower in Beijing to light 5 new studios for the CCTV news division.
- *Primer Impacto and Noticias* – Univision Television Network, Miami, FL  
As a subcontractor to The Lighting Design Group, Luminous Design Studios headed up the move and re-lighting of these 2 shows from the old Univision studios to the new Newsport building that came online in October, 2013.

As a walk-through museum, this attraction presents scenes depicting life on the ship as well as displays of the story of the construction, sailing, and sinking in the North Atlantic. Eric provided the complete show lighting design for the interior and exterior of the building.
- *Revenge of the Mummy - The Ride* – Universal Studios, Singapore  
Opened in early 2010, this attraction is a redesign of the original attraction based at Universal Orlando Resort. Eric provided the complete show lighting design for the attraction as well as on-site art direction during the installation.

More than just a library, this is an immersive exhibit taking the guest through various high points in the life of Billy Graham. A live, locally televised tribute to astronaut John Glenn. The event was hosted by Walter Cronkite and featured the surviving Mercury astronauts as well as various musical and dance entertainment.
- *AAA – Disney’s Magical Memories Dinner and Show* - Georgia World Congress Center, Atlanta, GA  
This show was produced by Disney exclusively for the AAA annual sales meeting. It was a 25-minute theatrical presentation incorporating 8 songs from Disney films sung by Disney characters with supporting singers and dancers. The lighting design included 60 moving lights on top of a large conventional package.
